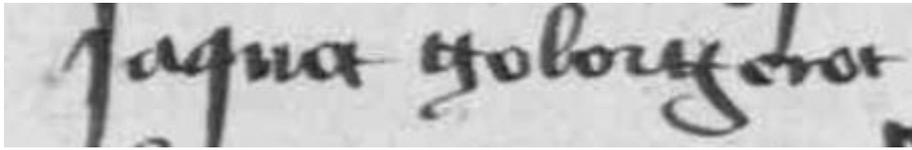


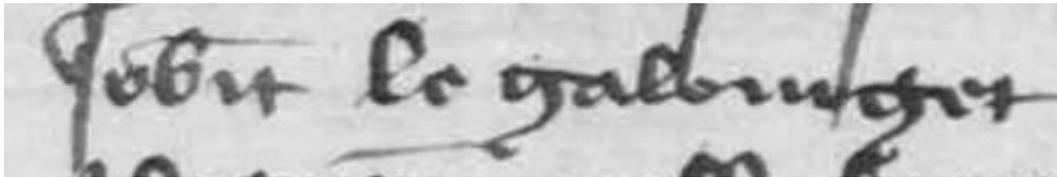
Les GUELORGET

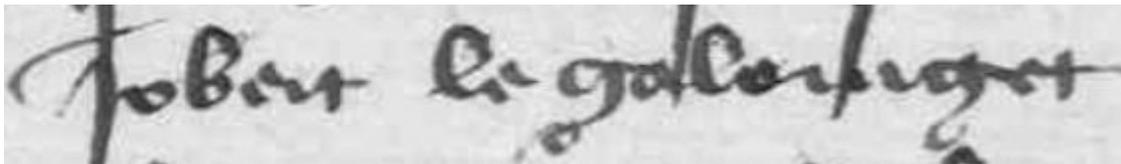
En voici quelques traces, en ce temps là il n'y avait pas grand monde sur Recey et n'oublions que les scribes écrivaient selon la phonétique.

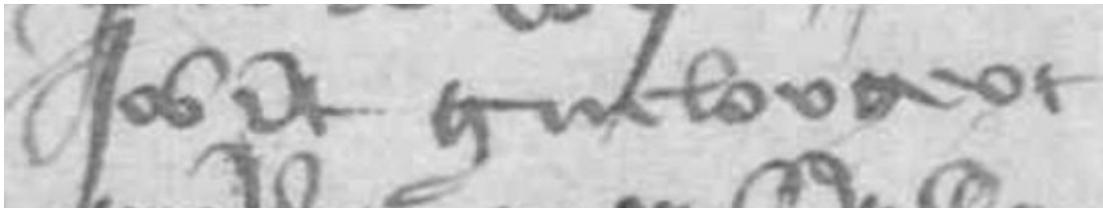
1397 jaquot golongerot (misérable)

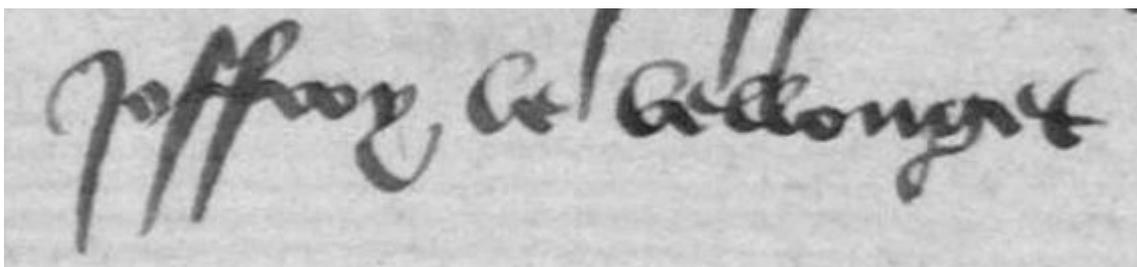

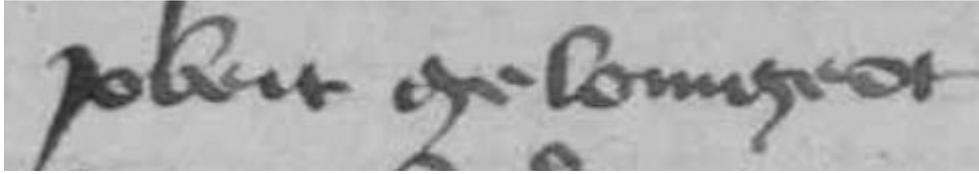

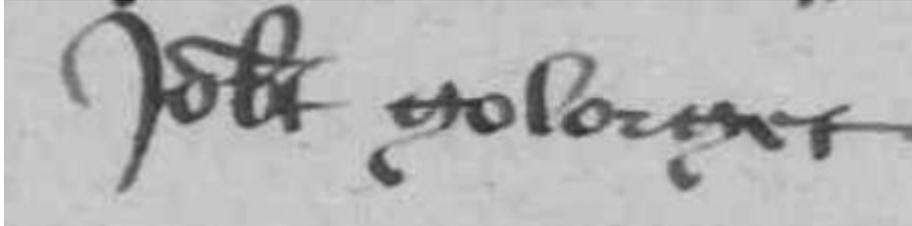
